

Security Barriers Give Peace of Mind



This version of our wooden Security Barrier includes a slant roof. Other options are a flat roof or a peaked roof. (Ramps ordered separately.)

The Hale Wooden Security Barrier™ provides an attractive way to protect your home from unwanted intrusion by people and animals.

It is designed to be installed directly in front of wall model pet doors. The barrier provides security in two ways. First, it works as camouflage of sorts by hiding your pet door. Our barriers are built to look like dog houses and planters. Their primary purpose is to block human access to your home. Your dog enters from the side on the open end and must turn to use the pet door. An animal can wind its way through but the limited space and angle of entry make it extremely difficult if not impossible for a human to access the pet door.

When combined with the Hale Cat GuardianTM, the barrier also deters unwanted cats or wild animals from entering the house through the pet door.

There are three models of the wooden Security Barrier: peaked roof, flat roof and slant roof. Take a look at all three and read more about this ingenious solution on our website's "Products" section.

Rescue Rewards: Texas Hearing and Service Dogs

Hale Pet Door is proud to welcome Texas Hearing and Service Dogs to our group of Rescue Rewards partners.

Founded in 1988 by attorney Sheri Soltes, THSD is a nonprofit organization that trains Service Dogs and Hearing Dogs to assist people with disabilities.

Hearing Dogs are trained to alert their deaf owners by touch and lead them to everyday sounds, such as a door knock, smoke alarm or telephone.

Service Dogs assist individuals with physical disabilities by opening doors, fetching wheelchairs, retrieving dropped items, operating light switches, moving paralyzed limbs and getting help.

THSD adopts all of their dogs from animal shelters and rescue leagues. Utilizing positive reinforcement, they train the dogs, pair them with their new partners and then train them as teams - all free of charge to the recipients.
